	Club membership is considered in the creating of the preliminary rounds. The setting of the preliminary round is based on the current status of the German Senior Ranking. Match on 5 hits, 3 minutes (time and equal hit according to FIE regulations) Match on 10 hits 2 x 3 minutes (time and equal hit according to FIE regulations) other regulations like F.I.E. (The TD reserves the right to change). Depending on the number of participants (eg combination of weakly occupied AK), the mode can be modified by the TD on site!	
<b>Rules and legal</b>	The event takes place according to FIE and DFB regulations. In addition: The fencers can only start in the age group they belong to. If less than 6 fencers compete in an age group, they must be in the next younger or older age group compete separately. Multiple start is possible.	
<b>Liability</b>	Organizer assume no liability. All participants are for responsible for the personal equipment.	
<b>Jurisdiction</b>	The participants submit to the jurisdiction of the German Fencing Association e.V.	
<b>Anti Doping</b>	Doping controls can be carried out.	
<b>Image / TV rights</b>	The participants and their legal representatives declare that they agree to a publication of their names, clubs and year of birth as the as the competition data.. The fencer / legal representative declares his consent to the production, distribution and display of images, sound and film during the competitions. This consent is free of charge, has unlimited territorial and temporal validity and applies to the right to the image as well as the general right of personality. It includes all media, but in particular the right to reproduce recordings in print, TV shows and the Internet. There is the possibility, but no obligation, to give the name.

<b>Equipment</b>	Equipment as defined by DFB, see <a href="http://www.fechten.org/downloads/">http://www.fechten.org/downloads/</a> Wearing a transparent mask is prohibited in all disciplines. Masks / mask cable: Grid and bib 1600N with test stamp FIE. Foil masks only with sewn on conductive bib. For the sword competitions taped foil masks are not allowed. In all tournaments, the use of spiral mask cables in the foil and saber weapons is no longer permitted, only smooth white or transparent mask cables are permitted. Blades: Foil: Maraging No. 5, (with stamp FIE.) Epee: Maraging No. 5, (with stamp FIE.); Sabre: standard blade No. 5, marking S-2000 Gloves for Sabre: FIE - Glove 800N, Foil and Epee gloves: closed Glove (with stamp FIE.) Fencing suit: Fencing suit 800 N and additional Plastron 800 N (stamp FIE.)
