The fencer / legal representative declares his consent to the production, distribution and display of images, sound and film during the competitions. This consent is free of charge, has unlimited territorial and temporal validity and applies to the right to the image as well as the general right of personality. It includes all media, but in particular the right to reproduce recordings in print, TV shows and the Internet. There is the possibility, but no obligation, to give the name.

Only athletes, accredited coaches and staff of the organizers are admitted to the competition. Spectators are not allowed to enter the event. All persons entering the site must be registered in the registration system before the registration deadline. Unregistered persons will not have access to the competition site.

The number of officials admitted to the tournament per club is limited.

Individual competitions:

- 1 to 3 fencers: 1 coach/official
- 4 to 6 fencers: 2 coach/official
- 7 and more fencers: 3 coaches/officials

Team competitions: 1 coach/official per team

THE COMPETITION WILL BE RUN AS A "2G++" EVENT: (VACCINATED or RECOVERED) PLUS (BOOSTERED or TESTED)

Details and exceptions according to the Hamburger Verordnung include

- \* pupils of 16-18 years are considered tested, but must be vaccinated or recovered; pupils below 16 years are not subject to the regulation
- \* negative tests have to be either certified rapid antigen tests not older than 24 hours, or PCR tests not older than 48 hours with respect to the start of the tournament as specified in the invitation. Self-tests are not accepted.
- \* persons who are infected with Corona or who are in officially ordered quarantine are not allowed to enter the venue.

The general hygienic rules apply at the venue. In particular, all persons who do not directly participate in sport or who are not just recovering must wear face masks (protection class FFP2 or medical mouth and nose protection).

Due to the current circumstances, no cafeteria will be offered at the tournament. All athletes and coaches are kindly asked to provide for themselves.

If necessary, the medical regulations will be adjusted in the tender. All participants and supervisors are asked to check for the current rules shortly before the tournament.
