AGE GROUPS: FIE Season 2024/2025

Minimum Age: No fencer under the age of 12 years on the 31st December 2024 may enter in the

official Ophardt categories.

Only Fencers who are eligible for the 2025 Cadet World Championship will be allowed to enter

Cadet (u17) competitions.

Only Fencers who are eligible for the 2025 Junior World Championship will be allowed to enter

Junior (u20) competitions.

1. Weapons, Masks, Electric Jackets, Body Wires, Mask Clips, Sabre Manchettes & Gloves are to be submitted to weapons check before the event, and will be checked again by the officiating

referees before pool and DE bouts.

2. Plastrons must be worn.

3. No tracksuit pants may be worn. Breeches and long socks only.

4. All fencers on the piste must have access to at least one spare working weapon, body wire and

mask clip at the side of the piste.

5. Electric jackets, mask bibs, sabre gloves & manchettes will be tested for dead spots.
