<b>Format</b>	The qualification rounds on Saturday consist of four rounds of poules and a preliminary direct elimination. No fencer is eliminated until after the last round of poules. The winners of each of the poules in round two, three or four are directly qualified for next day's competition, as well as those who qualifies from the DE round that completes the first day. The ranking of the fencers for the second day will be made according to what stage in the competition the fencer has qualified for the second day. Approximately half of the number of the participating fencers will be qualified for Sunday's DE, which will be fenced with repêchage.		
<b>Rules and legal</b>	In Swedish fencing competitions, the International Fencing Federation (FIE) regulations and other statutes apply with amendments and additions according to SvFF competition rules.  At all Swedish competitions, the federation's code of conduct is in effect. <b>Jurisdiction</b>	All participants are responsible for their own equipment.		
<b>Medical</b>	A healthcare professional (trained in first aid, cardiovascular/pulmonary rescue and sports injuries) must be present at the competition venue. A special place for the competition's medical care function should be visible to all participants and clearly shown.		
<b>Equipment</b>	U17, U20, Sen o Vet: Mask: FIE, Vest: FIE, Plastron: FIE, Breeches: FIE, Saber Glove: FIE, Breast protection dam: Required (foil: FIE) Blade: Standard (At Nordic Championships, FIE blades are mandatory in senior category) Max blade length: 5 Transparent body cord connectors and specific wiring through the guard connector! -		
<b>Awards</b>	FOUR HONORARY PRIZES WILL BE AWARDED: Johan Harmenberg's Honorary Prize is divided in two parts: The winner of the men's competition will receive a sum of 10,000 SEK, and the best male junior fencer (born 2003 or later) will be awarded 4,000 SEK.  Her Royal Highness Princess Birgitta's Honorary Prize is also divided in two parts: The winner of the women's competition will receive 10,000 SEK, and 4,000 SEK will be awarded to the best female junior fencer (born 2003 or later).		
<b>Directions</b>	The competition is held at Stora Mossens Idrottshallar by Stora Mossens IP in Bromma. The big white wooden building on the left hand side is the competition hall. There is plenty of parking space, however there is a parking fee all day. For underground travel, take the green line to station Stora Mossen, from which there is a 15
