Remarks	Covid-19 : In Bremen, the 2G rule applies to all sports participants and their accompanying persons from 14.02.2022. - Fully vaccinated or recovered (date of collection of positive swab is at least 28 days, and maximum 90 days ago). Exceptions: - Children and adolescents up to 18 years of age. Students 16 and older still need proof that they are tested regularly at school. When entering the premises of Bremen 1860: - wear an FFP2 mask (children under 16 may wear a surgical mask). - please show proof of vaccination or convalescence. - It is mandatory to carry the vaccination or convalescent certificate and the identity card/passport, as these documents must be shown in the event of a control. Contact details will no longer be collected.
