Fencers must sign-in for each competition at the Registration Table. Fencers are to sign the provided Attendance Register & Indemnity Forms with registration, at the registration desk. The Organising Committee reserves the right to change the order of the programme. Finishing times can only be estimated once all entries have been received. Such times are dependent on the number of entries, availability of Referees and the promptness of Fencers to present themselves on the Piste.		
	AGE GROUPS: FIE Season 2023/2024 Minimum Age: No fencer under the age of 12 years on the 31st December 2022 may enter National Open Competitions. Fencers over 8 years on the 31st December 2023 may enter Junior Nationals. Only Fencers who are eligible for the 2024 Cadet World Championship will be allowed to to enter Cadet (u17) competitions. Only Fencers who are eligible for the 2024 Junior World Championship will be allowed to to enter Junior (u20) competitions.

Plastrons must be worn. 3. No tracksuit pants may be worn. Breeches and long socks only. 4. All fencers on the piste must have access to at least one spare working weapon, body wire and mask clip at the side of the piste. 5. Electric jackets, mask bibs, sabre gloves & manchettes will be tested for dead spots.
