ENTRY: A Fencer will only be permitted to enter his/her own age group, and ONE up - Except where there is no event offered in the Age Group of the Fencer.
Fencers must sign-in for each competition at the Registration Table.
Fencers are to sign the provided Attendance Register & Indemnity Forms with registration, at the registration desk.
The Organising Committee reserves the right to change the order of the programme.
Finishing times can only be estimated once all entries have been received. Such times are dependent on the number of entries, availability of Referees and the promptness of Fencers to present themselves on the Piste.

AGE GROUPS: FIE Season 2023/2024

Minimum Age: No fencer under the age of 12 years on the 31st December 2022 may enter National Open Competitions. Fencers over 8 years on the 31st December 2023 may enter Junior Nationals. Only Fencers who are eligible for the 2024 Cadet World Championship will be allowed to enter Cadet (u17) competitions.
Only Fencers who are eligible for the 2024 Junior World Championship will be allowed to enter Junior (u20) competitions.

Minimum 350 N

1. Weapons, Masks, Electric Jackets, Body Wires, Mask Clips , Sabre Manchettes & Gloves are to be submitted to weapons check before the event, and will be checked again by the officiating referees before pool and DE bouts.
2. Plastrons must be worn.
3. No tracksuit pants may be worn. Breeches and long socks only.
4. All fencers on the piste must have access to at least one spare working weapon, body wire and mask clip at the side of the piste.
5. Electric jackets, mask bibs, sabre gloves & manchettes will be tested for dead spots.

At O.R. Tambo Kempton Park, 1627
Get on R21 from Bonaero Dr and Exit 41 - 8 min (5.4 km)
Follow R21, N1 and N4 to R566 in Onderstepoort, Pretoria. Take exit 276 from N4 - 39 min (67.2 km)
Continue on R566. Drive to Eeufees St in Pretoria North - 8 min (6.5 km)
Turn right onto R566 (signs for Pretoria) 3.6 km
Turn right onto M1 900 m
Use the right lane to take the President Steyn Street exit 650 m
Continue onto President Steyn St 1.1 km
Turn left onto Eeufees St - Destination will be on the right 160 m
