Format The competition formula and rules are according to the rules and regulations of the Swedish Fencing Federation.
Formula:
2 rounds of poules and direct elimination or A+B+C poule finals for U11 open
2 rounds of poules and direct elimination for U13, U15, U17, U20
1 round of poules and direct elimination for senior classes
Men and women compete in separate classes if not the number of participants demand a mixed class.
Ängby Fäktklubb has the right to change the formula and starttime for classes after the final day for registration due to the Covid-19 situation and the corresponding rules and regulations.

Rules and legal In Swedish fencing competitions, the International Fencing Federation (FIE) regulations and other statutes apply with amendments and additions according to SvFF competition rules.

Jurisdiction All participants are responsible for their own equipment.
