AGE GROUPS: FIE Season 2023/2024

Minimum Age: No fencer under the age of 12 years on the 31st December 2022 may enter National Open Competitions. Fencers over 8 years on the 31st December 2023 may enter Junior Nationals. Only Fencers who are eligible for the 2024 Cadet World Championship will be allowed to to enter Cadet (u17) competitions.

1. Weapons, Masks, Electric Jackets, Body Wires, Mask Clips, Sabre Manchettes & Gloves are to be submitted to weapons check before the event, and will be checked again by the officiating referees before pool and DE bouts.

2. Plastrons must be worn.

3. No tracksuit pants may be worn. Breeches and long socks only.

4. All fencers on the piste must have access to at least one spare working weapon, body wire and mask clip at the side of the piste.

5. Electric jackets, mask bibs, sabre gloves & manchettes will be tested for dead spots.
